Hands-on practice reinforces those skills and one-on-one support and guidance from a certified instructor increase comprehension and retention of course material.

One-On-One Mentoring

Certified Instructors, or mentors, are present throughout the student's learning cycle. Mentors can answer questions and provide additional instruction when needed to help increase the student's

comprehension and retention of the course material.

For instance, the mentor always knows where the students are in the coursework and is aware when they reach a point in the course known to be difficult. The mentor can then communicate additional information and assistance to guide the student through that portion of the training in addition to providing ongoing support throughout the entire course.

Flexible Scheduling

Training is delivered on demand, allowing students to determine when they attend training and for how long. An individual has access to training at any time during Mentored Learning classroom hours. 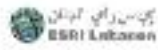
